


Scope and Topics of the Conference

The 4th International Conference on Scanning Probe Spectroscopy (SPS'06) will be held in Hamburg, Germany on July 23-26, 2006, following the previous conferences in 1997 and 2003 in Pozńan, Poland, and 2000 in Hamburg.
